Upholding Trinity church by prayer is something everyone can do. I WILL UPHOLD THE CHURCH WITH MY PRESENCE... This vow calls for dedication of all three areas of our being...body, mind, and spirit. By being present at the services in God's Church we strengthen our own individual relationships with God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit in us. I should mention here that there is an experience that we feel when this sanctuary is comforably filled which simply does not occur when it is only partially filled. The Apostle Paul considered that effective, responsible stewardship individual and congregational way of acknowledging our partnership and indebtedness to God for His generous spiritual

when we acknowledge that God is the sovereign owner of all things including our lives...When we give real evidence of our gratitude to God for His immeasurable gift of salvation in Jesus Christ...When we present an actual part of ourselves in the form our financial support of His Church both here and around the world we are responding to God's love as we experience it from day to day.... we are upholding this church by our financial giving.... Investing in the total ministery of His Church.

I WILL UPHOLD THE CHURCH WITH MY SERVICE...The most distinctive mark of the early followers of " The Way ". which would later become The Christian Church was their eagerness to be of Christ-Link service to others. Thay had heard Jesus say , " If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me". They had learned from Jesus that "whosoever seeks to save his life shall lose it, but whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it." What does this mean? Well, we all have our individual crosses to bear in our daily lives. When we dwell on them excessively we become almost to a point of paralization. But, when our minds are focused on the workings of this, or any other church our crosses seem easier to bear. Paul said it well in his letter to the Corinthian church. He wrote, " There are different ways of serving, but it is the Lord who is being served. There are different abilities to perform service, but it is the same God who imparts those abilities to us...then Paul goes on to list some of the needs of the church. A few minutes ago heard me down Dr. Kline's "Vision List". There are numerous ways to serve Trinity in that list.

When we uphold the church by our <u>service</u> we are upholding our very Lord who said ,"In as much as you did it unto the least of these my brethern you did it unto me." God is asking us today as He did in the days of the Prophet Isaiah..." Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? And He wants us to respond "Here I am Lord. Send me."

Dr. Kline wrote this in his pastoral report at our charge conference last November. Commenting on his vision for Tginity for the year 2000 and beyond, he wrote, "

Our goal and ministry is to study, share and serve. Our role as a congregation can be summed up in the words of St. Paul

"Each has his/her own special gift from God. One of one kind and one of another." Our concern is for our people within the walls of Trinity Church as those outside her walls. In our service to all of God's children whom God dearly loves, we find ourselves in the mission of our church. The church is most assuredly the means of God's salvation to the world and we are His instruments of service...just wars and all with our own special talents big or small. It is a cause and purpose for which we must organize now and in the years to the in the 21st Century. Let us proper.

Father, as we approach this new year 2000, and the years that come aftergrant that by all of us praying together, giving together and serving together we will build Your Church, this church to Your Service. Grant that by using the gifts and graces you have given each one of us, we will truly be a church filled with Your Holy Spiritual Power that will each to minister to ourselves and others in so many ways also grow to belo and there.
